### Sixth Sunday of Easter

All you need is love

Today's Gospel offers one of the most eloquent passages on love in the Gospels. It reveals the vision of Jesus for his followers and explains how we should treat one another. We are to love each other with the same love Jesus showed during his time on earth, that great and generous love that culminated in his 'laying down his life for his friends'. It is in the way we love one another, the way we understand and forgive and support one another, that we experience the life and love of Jesus.

There are more than 20 references to love in today's readings. In the second reading we hear that 'everyone who loves is begotten by God and knows God'. That love that God showed by sending his Son for us, is the same generous, wholehearted, self-sacrificing love we are called to show others - all others. God does not have favourites. 'We find it so hard to accept the revelation that it is God's delight to be worshipped in the way we touch and look at each other, in the way we listen and talk to each other, in the way we forgive and promise to start all over again.' (Daniel O'Leary)

This year Pope Francis inaugurated a "Rosary Relay" or "Marathon of Prayer" for an end to the COVID-19 pandemic. Throughout the month of May the Rosary will be prayed from a different Marian shrine every day. A Rosary marathon calendar has been published naming the shrine at which the Rosary will be said and the special intention each day - it will be from Knock on May 10th.

<b>May 12:</b> Notre-Dame d'Afrique (Algeria): Prayer for lonely people who have lost hope
<b>May 13:</b> Shrine of the Blessed Virgin of the Holy Rosary (Portugal): Prayer for prisoners.
<b>May 14:</b> Our Lady of Health (India): Prayer for scientists and medical research institutes.
<b>May 15:</b> Mary Queen of Peace (Bosnia and Herzegovina): Prayer for migrants.
<b>May 16:</b> St. Mary's Cathedral (Sydney): Prayer for victims of violence and trafficking.
