Thirty Third Sunday in Ordinary Time



Sunday 13 November 2022 is the sixth World Day of the Poor, with the theme of "For your sakes Christ became poor" (2 Cor 8:9).

Pope Francis, in his message for the day, laments that just as the world was emerging from the "tempest of the pandemic", a new catastrophe appeared on the horizon: the Russian invasion of Ukraine and the brutal war which has followed. The war has displaced millions of Ukrainian people and caused global economic turbulence, with food shortages and rising energy costs which will affect the poorest this winter.

The Pope reminds us of the generosity of people in welcoming refugees from recent conflicts in the Middle East. He understands that host communities can feel burdened, and it is difficult to maintain relief efforts, but he says, "This is the moment for us not to lose heart but to renew our initial motivation. The work we have begun needs to be brought to completion with the same sense of responsibility.

Pope Francis notes that the year comes "as a healthy challenge, helping us to reflect on our style of life and on the many forms of poverty all around us."
