First Sunday of Advent



Lighting of the first candle on the advent wreath: The first candle, which is purple, symbolizes hope. It is sometimes called the "Prophecy Candle" in remembrance of the prophets, who foretold the birth of Christ. It represents the expectation felt in anticipation of the coming Messiah.

Advent (from 'ad-venire' in Latin or 'to come to') is the Church season encompassing the four Sundays and weekdays leading up to the celebration of Christmas. Advent is a time of spiritual preparation for the Lord's coming at Christmas.
