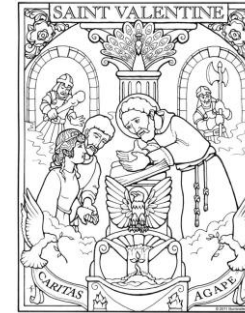

Feast Day of St. Valentine – 14th February



St. Valentine is the Patron Saint of engaged couples, bee keepers, epilepsy, fainting, greetings, happy marriages, love, plague, travellers, and young people. Saint Valentine was a clergyman in the Roman Empire who ministered to persecuted Christians. One of the many legends about him is that in the 3rd century AD it is said that Valentine, who was a priest, defied the order of the emperor Claudius and secretly performed Christian weddings for couples, allowing the husbands involved to escape conscription into the pagan army. He was martyred and his body buried at a Christian cemetery in Rome on February 14 269 AD. Fr. John Spratt received a gift from Pope Gregory XVI in 1836 containing a small vessel "tinged" with St. Valentine's blood. This gift now stands placed in Whitefriar Street Church in Dublin. Although the Roman Catholic Church continues to recognize St. Valentine as a saint of the church, he was removed from the General Roman Calendar in 1969 because of the lack of reliable information about him.
