Thy will be done ...

Holy week has a lot of structure and "outer" practices. Traditionally we have the procession and drama of Palm Sunday and, on Holy Thursday, we remember the Last Supper. Then we have Good Friday with the three hours at the cross, and the emptiness of Holy Saturday with all the questions that the empty tomb poses. We can do all the "outer" things, but if they do not touch our hearts then we have wasted our time. To truly keep Holy Week is a demanding experience, but as with all of Lent, the more you seek to protect and insulate yourself from it, the less you will be able to enter into it. So, open up, and let it all – pain and joy – sink in.
