## **Knockninny Parish Newsletter**

Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time 18<sup>th</sup> June 2023



In any year there are 33 or 34 Sundays in Ordinary time, depending on the date of Easter. Green is the normal liturgical colour for ordinary time. It is the colour of hope.

The term 'ordinary' in English often means something that is not special or distinctive. Yet Ordinary Time makes up most of the liturgical year in the Church. Ordinary Time in our Church Calendar is far from unimportant & uninteresting.

Ordinary Time follows the Christmas season. It ends when Lent begins. A second portion of Ordinary Time follows after Pentecost and culminates with the feast of Christ the King, and this leads us into the season of Advent.

The story of the life, mission, message and ministry of Jesus unfolds for us during Ordinary Time: miracles, parables, the calling of the 12 apostles, the Sermon on the Mount, the gift of the Bread of Life, all connect us to the Gospel Way that we are invited to follow.

Ordinary Time is anything but ordinary. It is the time that God does extraordinary things in the lives of ordinary people. It is becoming aware that the everyday moments of our ordinary lives are charged with God's presence.

We all try to follow the Gospel Way in the ordinariness of here and now, in the muddle, the mess, the mystery and mundane. This is where God is.
