This Sunday is Safeguarding Sunday in the Diocese of Kilmore. It is the day where we highlight just how much safeguarding everyone is a vital part of our day-to-day life in the parish. We have learned from the past and use it to create and uphold the highest safeguarding standards.

It is the day where we promote and remind everyone involved in the church that safeguarding is a standard practice for us all. Safeguarding includes children, but it also includes everyone who we meet in our daily interactions.

The diocese's policy is, as a constituent member of the Catholic Church in Ireland we recognise and uphold the dignity and rights of all children and are committed to ensuring their safety and well-being, and will work in partnership with parents/guardians to do this. We recognise each child as a gift from God, and we value and encourage the participation of children in all activities that enhance their spiritual, physical, emotional, intellectual and social development. All Church personnel (including clergy, religious, staff, volunteers) have a responsibility to safeguard children through promoting their welfare, health and development in a safe and caring environment which supports their best interests and prevents abuse.
