Today's Gospel, is the Vine and the Branches, and Jesus explains to his disciples that he is the vine, and we are the branches, and his Father is the caretaker, the gardener, the dresser of the vineyard.

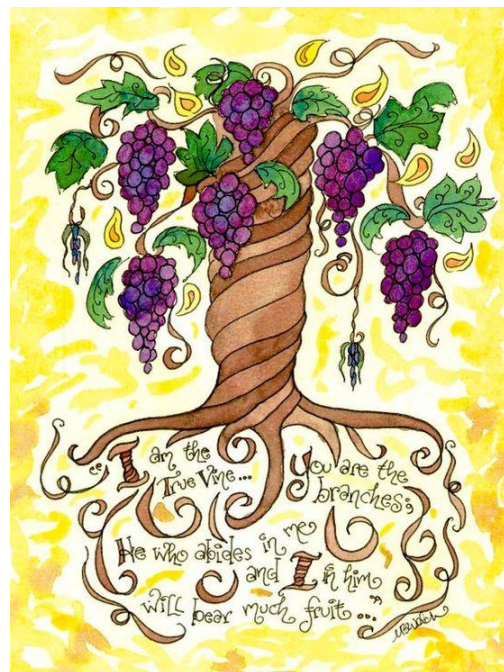
It is very important when Jesus says to us "I am the vine and you are the branches," what he really means is that we, as Christians, do not just walk with him. He is within us, in each other, in our community, in those outside our community. Because he has become, through his own

incarnation he has become incarnate in every human being.

And that means that, when we look at each other, we must look at each other the way he is. When we treat each other, we must treat each other the way we are, not just solitary individuals being nice to each other. We are people who are filled with the life of God in an intimacy that will last for all eternity.

And this is why today Jesus says to them, "You cannot separate the vine from the branches. You cannot separate the branches from the vine."
