But how can so little feed so many?

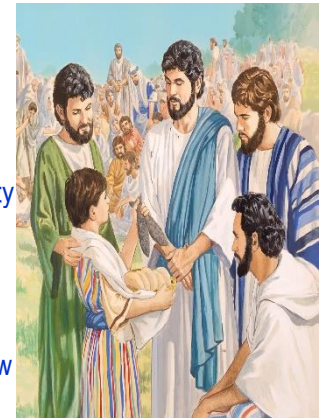
Jesus took the loaves and gave thanks and then there was plenty
