


Prayer of the Faithful

Second Sunday of Lent



- 1.** We pray for the Church and its leaders; that they may inspire people to seek and to discover the love of God in their lives. Lord, hear us.

- 3.** We pray for all those who have to live in the darkness of despair or depression. We pray that they may discover the light of hope in the words of Jesus Christ, our saviour. Lord, hear us.
- 4.** On this Mothers' Day, we pray for all mothers. We thank God for the gifts of life and love they've given us and for the faith they have shared with us. Lord, hear us.

Weekend 21st & 22nd March 2026

Fifth Sunday of Lent



1. We pray for our church: that in this time of darkness for the whole world, it may proclaim to all people the good news of the eternal life won for us by Jesus Christ. Lord, hear us.
2. In our Gospel today we met Martha and Mary as they grieved for their brother. We pray for all those who have been recently bereaved and who are mourning the death of someone close to them. May the Lord heal their wounds and turn their sorrow into joy. Lord, hear us.
3. We pray for those who have given up or lost the faith, that the Holy Spirit may open their minds and their hearts to the mystery of God's presence. Lord, hear us.
4. We pray for those in our community who are sick. May they experience God's healing power through the tenderness and care of those who look after them. Lord, hear us.
