We held our annual club awards evening in St Ninnidh's Hall last Sunday, thanks to everyone who came.


Special thanks to Ann Marie and Bronagh for providing the refreshments, Yvette, Enda and family for setting up the hall.



DAY OF PRAYER FOR TEMPERANCE

Temperance brings balance and
prevents excess getting a grip

Sunday 15th February is a Day of Prayer for Temperance, a day which offers us an opportunity to reflect on our relationship with various forms of addiction and a day on which we can take time to pray for those who suffer from addiction.



Apostle of Temperance Father Theobald Mathew (1790-1856) was a Capuchin friar from Co. Tipperary whose 19th century crusade against the abuse of alcohol gained him the title of "Apostle of Temperance". Father Mathew became president of the Cork Total Abstinence Society. Between 1838 and 1842 he travelled throughout Ireland. People flocked to hear him, and whole crowds took the temperance pledge. The number of abstainers in Ireland alone in 1841 was estimated to be 4,647,000, and in three years the consumption of spirits

dropped approximately 50 percent—much of this decrease attributable to Father Mathew's efforts. He went to Scotland and England in 1842–43 and to the United States in 1849, where, despite failing health, he preached in 25 states.

**Compassionate Lord and Saviour,
you inspired the Capuchin Friar Theobald Mathew
to show your compassionate face to those addicted
and burdened by the abuse of alcohol or addicted behaviour,
and to promote temperance.**

**May we today, continue to serve our brothers and sisters with love
and joy,
And to foster balance, and moderation in our life styles with the
help of God.
So, we pray, "here goes in the name of God."
