## HOLY WEEK



### Palm Sunday

Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem. The crowds welcome him by waving palm branches and shouting, "Hosanna to the Son of David! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest!"

### Holy Monday

Jesus returns with his disciples to Jerusalem. When Jesus arrives at the Temple, he finds it full of corruption. He overturns tables and clears the Temple. Mary of Bethany anoints Jesus with perfume.

### Holy Tuesday

Jesus preaches on the Mount of Olives.

### Holy Wednesday

Jesus announces the betrayal of one of the twelve apostles.

### Holy Thursday

Jesus washes his disciples' feet as they prepare to share in the Passover. The last supper takes place. Jesus is betrayed with a kiss by Judas Iscariot and arrested by the Sanhedrin. In the early morning hours, as Jesus' trial is getting underway, Peter denies knowing his Master three times before the rooster crows.

### Good Friday

Jesus endures the shame of false accusations, condemnation, mockery, beatings, and abandonment. After multiple unlawful trials, he is sentenced to death by crucifixion. About the ninth hour (3 p.m.), Jesus breathes his last breath and dies. In the evening, Jesus' body is taken down from the cross and is laid in a tomb.

### Holy Saturday

Jesus' body lays in its tomb, where it is guarded by Roman soldiers throughout the day. Christ's body is ceremonially treated for burial with spices purchased by Nicodemus.
