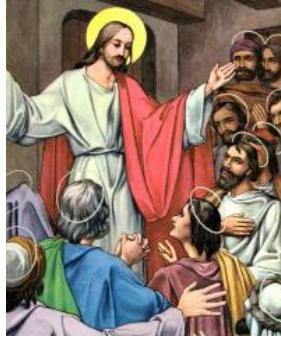


Prayer of the Faithful

- 4.** We pray for those who are sick. May their faith and their trust in God be a source of hope and a source of healing for them. Lord, hear us.

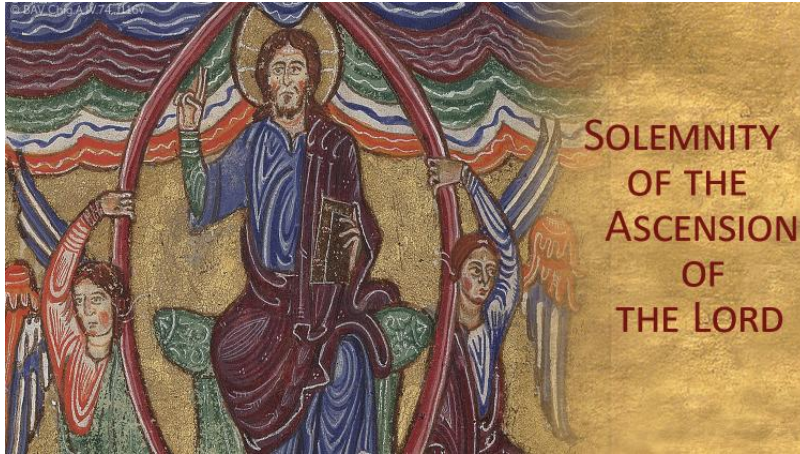
Prayer of the Faithful
