Clachan Court: Clachan Court Coffee Morning continues on Tuesday and we are delighted to see so many faces. Why not come along and join us.

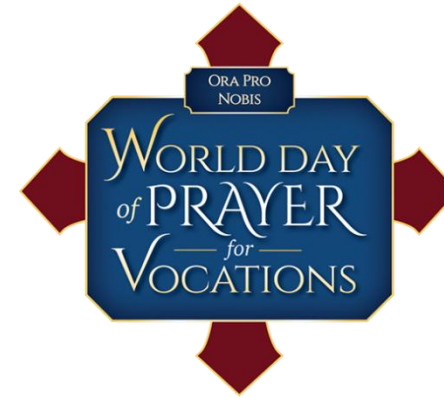
