Gentlemen, your pardon, this is my effort's end,

I kneel within your shadow,

Capt Verschoyle – Will the Secretary be able to make a suitable reply?

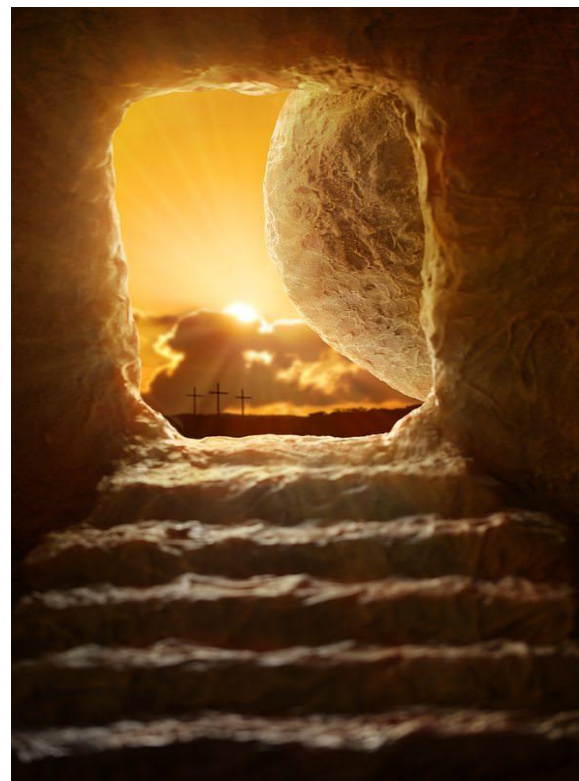
Chairman – Refer it the County Surveyor. He will provide a Poet Laureate. (Laughter)
