

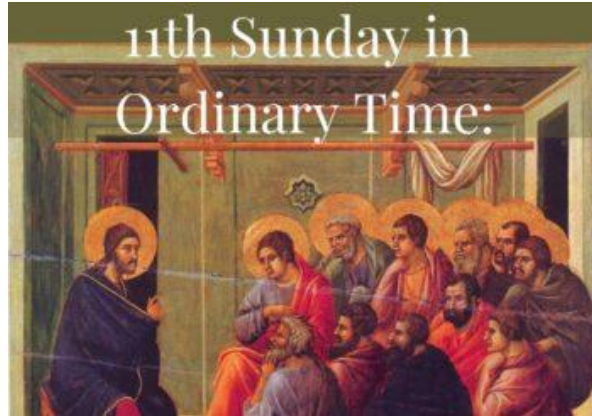
# Prayer of the Faithful
