Congratulations to the boys 7 girls from St. Ninnidh's Primary School who made their First Holy Communion this weekend.

Sunday by Sunday we are moving on from the Resurrection of Jesus towards Pentecost. The forty days from Resurrection to Ascension were a time of transition for the Apostles. They had to advance from knowing Jesus in the flesh to knowing the unseen God in faith. As the Risen Lord said to Thomas, "Blessed are those who have not seen but yet believe."

In today's Gospel Jesus speaks of "another Advocate to be with you forever."

"Advocate" is a Latin word meaning a friend/helper called to your assistance. The first Advocate was Jesus, the Son of God come in human flesh, one with us. "The Word was made flesh and dwelt among us".

The other or second Advocate is the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit would be sent, Jesus explained, to teach and to remind. This was a specific promise to the apostles, who were granted definite authority from Jesus, including the authority to teach, to govern, and to forgive sins in his name and by his power.
